Board of Directors: Elected governing body of the Chamber. Must meet eligibility requirements and be elected.

Executive Committee: Officers and elected leaders of the Chamber's Board of Directors. Board election required.

Finance Committee: Appointed committee by Chamber's Board Chair, responsible for regular review and oversight of Chamber's financial performance, policies and procedures.

Audit Committee: Appointed committee by Chamber's Board Chair, responsible for annual audit findings and presentation to the Board. Must meet eligibility requirements.

Nominating Committee: Appointed committee by Chamber's Board Chair, responsible for annual review and selection of new and returning Board members as outlined by Bylaws.

Foundation Board of Directors: Elected governing body of the Plano Works Leadership Foundation. Must meet eligibility requirements and be elected.

Public Policy Committee: Member driven committee who gathers to receive regular updates and input into Federal, State and local policy updates and elected official engagement. Creates policy priorities and recommendations positions on impactful legislation.

Infrastructure Committee: Monitors and advocates for policies, investments, and projects that support a strong business environment, including transportation, utilities, broadband, water, and public facilities, offering experience and relationships with experts in this field.

YPP Advisory Board: Elected leadership of the Young Professionals Program. Must meet eligibility requirements.

LP Advisory Board: Elected leadership of the Leadership Plano program. Must meet eligibility requirements.

Women's Division Committee: Member driven committee leading and planning women in business centered programming through topic discussion, speaker evaluation and general event leadership.

Talent & Workforce Committee: Member and Foundation investor driven committee gathering members of the Talent Advancement Network to review, recommend and discuss trends and opportunities in Talent recruitment, growth and retention.

Chamber Champions Committee: Member driven committee comprised of outgoing individuals dedicated to encouraging membership engagement and retention.

Communications Committee: Member driven committee of industry leaders in the field of marketing, communications and events, dedicated to supporting and offering expertise to the Chamber's messaging, storytelling and critical communication efforts.

Technology & Data Committee: Member driven committee of industry experts in the fields of data collection and review, AI, advanced technologies, cyber security and more, dedicated to supporting the Chamber's efforts in educating and advocating for members with regards to these areas.

Governance Task Force: Working group of Board members who review policies and bylaw updates as needed. Must meet eligibility requirements.

Facilities Task Force: Working group of members and advisors, tasked with reviewing and recommending facilities for the Chamber's operations.

Membership Task Force: Working group of members and advisors, tasked with reviewing and recommending updates to the Chamber's menu of membership benefits, cost structure and member-driven revenue streams.
