Plano Prime Curriculum and Calendar for 2019

January 9, 2019	CLASS WELCOME RECEPTION (attendance required) 5:30 - 7:00 p.m. Plano Chamber of Commerce Class members meet for the first time and are introduced to Plano Prime Committee members, the Leadership Plano Board and program alumni.
January 15, 2019	YOU AND YOUR CITY Participants gain insights into the city's history and an appreciation of what makes Plano a "City of Excellence" while meeting with city officials and learning about opportunities for involvement in their city.
January 29, 2019	COMMUNITY AND PERSONAL PROTECTION Police and Fire Department personnel provide an overview of crime prevention, emergency response, public safety and programs available for more in-depth learning about police and fire operations.
February 12, 2019	LIFELONG LEARNING Presentations by representatives of Plano ISD, Collin College and the City of Plano Library Department explore educational opportunities for students and family members, school finance, community partnerships, and volunteer opportunities.
February 26, 2019	HERITAGE AND CULTURAL ARTS Participants gain an awareness of the city's heritage and explore the varied cultural arts and entertainment opportunities available as they enjoy artistic presentations and tour the downtown Arts District.
March 12, 2019	LIFESTYLE ENHANCEMENT THROUGH FITNESS AND FUN! A trip to one of the city's highly rated recreation centers, with a visit to the Plano Senior Recreation Center, showcases the many fitness activities and classroom enrichment programs available to citizens of all ages in our community.
March 26, 2019	WELLNESS AND HUMAN SERVICES Presentations by local healthcare providers offer a look into patient care and issues affecting healthcare institutions and personal well-being. Participants also gain insights into social services available to those in need and the many opportunities for involvement. At the end of the session, class members participate in a "Program Completion Ceremony and Reception." (Ceremony from 4:30-6:30 p.m. Guests welcome.)

All sessions begin at 8:30 a.m. and end at 4:00 p.m. except for the last session which is extended to include a "Program Completion Celebration".
